

Scholarship frequently asked questions?

Can I be awarded the scholarship more than once? Yes, you can be awarded the scholarship up to 4 times in your first 4 years of college studies.

I'm a high school senior and don't know where I will be going to college. May I apply? Yes, we understand you may not know where you will be attending when you apply. Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the college you choose.

I have not been active with the chapter since I have been away at school. Do I qualify? Yes, we look at your overall participation in the chapter and community, not just one year.

What is the amount I will receive if I get the scholarship? The amount will vary. The minimum is \$250.

Will I receive the money? The scholarship will be sent to the institution directly under your name.

Is there more than one scholarship? Yes.

I'm a JACL member, but not a Silicon Valley JACL member. Can I apply for a scholarship? No, you must be Silicon Valley JACL member.

The application doesn't list GPA, do grades matter? Scholarships will be awarded mainly based on chapter and community participation but other criteria may also be used.

Can I apply once and receive scholarships every year I attend college? No, you must re-apply each year for that year's scholarship.
